Muritai Yacht Club (Inc) is committed to supporting and encouraging members taking part in the sport of sailing, in a safe and healthy manner for the individuals and supporters involved, and for the environment in which we operate.

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY:

To support our Health and Safety policy statement we are committed to the following duties:

- Undertake and record a risk assessment of the club premises, equipment and sailing waters, and the activities undertaken by the club.
- Create a safe environment by putting health and safety measures in place for risks identified by the assessment.
- Appoint a competent club member to assist with health and safety responsibilities.
- Ensure those responsibilities are shared by all officers of the club.
- Ensure that all members are aware of, understand and follow the club's health and safety policy.
- Ensure that all members are given the appropriate level of safety training and competition training (depending on ability, age, maturity and development).
- Ensure adequate communications, first aid facilities and qualified first aiders are available all times during scheduled club activity.
- Report and record any injuries or accidents sustained during any club activity or whilst on the club premises.
- Review this Policy and duties at least annually.

AS A CLUB MEMBER YOU HAVE A DUTY TO:

- Comply with the club's policy on health and safety issues.
- Take reasonable care for your own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by what you do or don't do.
- Correctly use any equipment provided by the club.
- ***Take responsibility for your own safety if you choose to sail outside of scheduled club activity.***

FIRST AID:

- Location of first aid facilities: Rescue boats, Clubhouse kitchen
- Location of telephones/radios: VHF Radios on rescue boats, with beach manager & in start-box, phone by kitchen in Clubhouse
- Contact for assistance: Start-box officials, beach manager or rescue boat crews
